Ever wondered what life must have been like for the disciples who walked, talked and lived with Jesus for the final three and half years of Jesus' life on earth? To see firsthand the miracles performed, to hear the revelation of truth dispensed as never before. To see their hope hang on a cross, all their dreams, hopes and visions of life dashed when Jesus was laid in the tomb? One moment filled with answers, the next filled with anxieties. It was a hope and fear difference.

Wondering is not bad, but if prolonged can lead to living in the past. I remember one of my seminary professors emphasizing to us young pastors that we should always be aware that our call is to be a people who journey together, with the congregation, toward God's kingdom. One cure to break the pattern of "ever wondered" is to be in active and growing relationships. As disciples of Jesus Christ we are called to be a people who are in relationship with God and with each other. We are called to be a people who are about the business of living lives which reflect Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. We are called to be a people who are willing to sacrifice so that unity and mission may be accomplished. We are called to be the people of God in our community. We can never be the people of God alone. It requires at least three relationships: First, we are required to have a relationship with God. Secondly, we are required to have a relationship with each other. Third, we are required to have a relationship with the world.

Kathryn and I are excited for all of our friends at Rockport to begin your relationship with your new Pastor, The Rev. Lorrin Radzic. It is our prayer that each of you will, through this transition, move from "I wonder" and journey toward becoming a more faithful Disciple of Christ.


